No.HFW (E)-42/2000/7691-7704.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to the Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the General Arunachal Pradesh Health Service Rules, 2000 namely :

- Short title and commencement** : (1) These rules may be called the General Arunachal Pradesh Health Services Rules (Amendment) Rules, 2024.
- They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Arunachal Pradesh Gazette.
- Amendment** : In Principal Rule notified vide No. HFW (E)- 42/2000 dated 3rd August, 2001 for the existing entries the following entries shall be substituted, namely :
